Objectives for teaching should include:

- Introduce participating students to the basic concepts of the visual arts; teach basic principles of each art medium offered
- Mentor and develop relationships, fostering a positive experience for students; boost selfesteem by encouraging creative self expression
- Share the significance of project completion, a strong work ethic, and of having a respect for creativity and the arts
