## **Programming-Comedy & Experiential**

#### **Comedy & Experiential Programming Internship**

Comedy & Experiential Programming Interns will get hands-on experience with programming ArtsQuest's many comedy shows while also learning the necessities of running a wide array of experience-based events. This internship is open to all majors, but those with a background in Comedy, Performing Arts, and/or Event Planning will find it particularly valuable.

## Responsibilities may include:

- Aid in the coordination of comedy bookings
- Review materials submitted by artists, coordinate on-going performer files, and review performer contracts as they relate to producing events.
- Securing necessary resources to fulfill performer riders and contracts.
- Assist with organizing and setting up event posters and advertisements
- Attend Comedy Committee and Experiential Committee meetings
- Interns will be required to work at least 16-24 hours per week, or as needed to fulfill credit requirements.

  Though schedule is flexible, interns will need be available most Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings

- Ability to set and adhere to strict deadlines
